What's New?

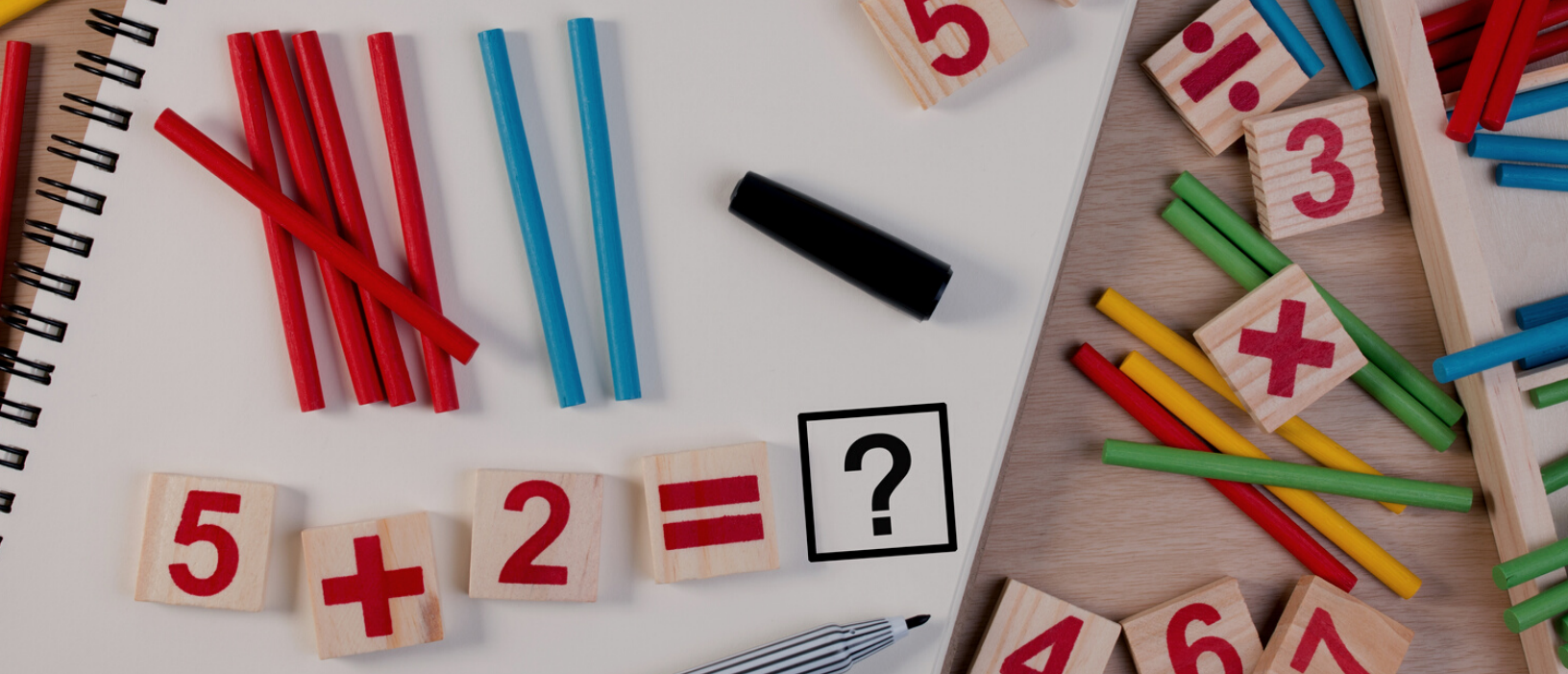

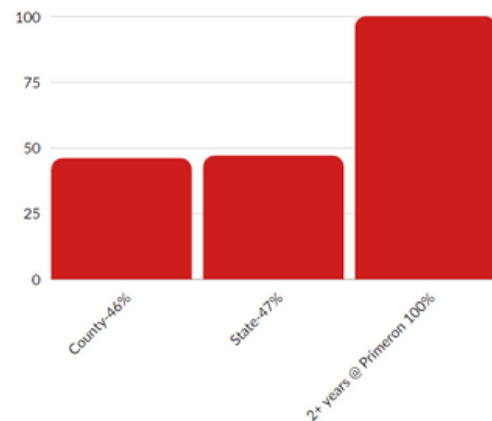


Academics

Kindergarten Readiness Assessments: In September of 2020, we administered the KRA to our 5-year-old children entering Kindergarten. The results showed that 100% of children, who have attended the **Primeron Family** for 2 or more years, had scores showing they were ready for Kindergarten. In contrast, by county and state, only an average of 46.5% of 5-year-old children given KRA showed scores indicating Kindergarten Readiness.

*KRA score of 60% or higher indicates Kindergarten Readiness, per state of MD.

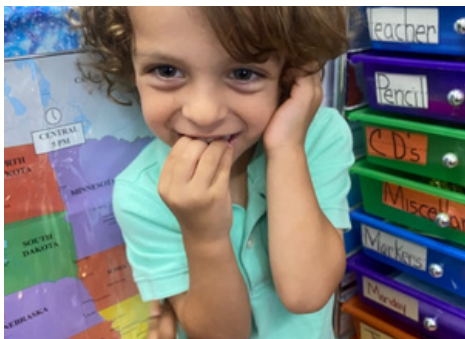
