


Academics

Kindergarten Readiness Assessments: In September of 2020, we administered the KRA to our 5-year-old children entering Kindergarten. The results showed that 100% of children, who have attended the Elevon for 2 or more years, had scores showing they were ready for Kindergarten. In contrast, by county and state, only an average of 46.5% of 5-year-old children given KRA showed scores indicating Kindergarten Readiness.

Homework Update: After instituting the new homework system in the lobby, we have seen an increase in homework completion! Homework has many benefits including: keeping parents informed about what their child is learning every day, HOW their child is doing with the taught concepts, and provides parents an opportunity to connect with their child about what their child experienced while at school.


Home-Work All Stars
